Dear Partners,

I can't believe it's already March 2011. I am so grateful to our Lord for His mercy and grace. We were very busy in February. We were able to distribute 18 bibles, translated in the native tribal Luo tongue of the village pastors, help feed and clothe 5 widows and 14 orphans. Additionally, we now have spiritual oversight of 8 pastors and churches, with over 500 members. What does all this mean? God is MOVING and we get to be a part of it.



Meet Golvin Kipchumba. He is 1 of the 14 orphans we are caring for in Kenya. Golvin and his brothers were born HIV positive, and a few months ago he lost one of his older brothers to AIDS. Although Golvin needs medical treatment for HIV, his most immediate need is nutrition. It takes \$300 a month to provide 3 meals a day for the 5 widows and 14 orphans we take care of in Kenya.

That's right...for less than .50 cents a day, we can feed each of them 3 meals. We spend more on a candy bar or soda.
